



## Accessibility in Buckingham town centre: A commitment to inclusion

Our wonderful Buckingham town centre, adorned with its historic listed buildings and charming independent shops, is proud to champion accessibility. Local business and shop owners are dedicated to making Buckingham an inclusive and welcoming town for everyone.

- Shops & businesses: While many businesses have limitations in accommodating
  mobility scooters, over half of our shops and establishments are fully accessible for
  wheelchairs and pushchairs and many shop owners are more than willing to assist by
  bringing goods out to customers if needed.
- Dining options: There is a diverse range of dining options in the town with most establishments being accessible for wheelchairs and pushchairs. These venues are equipped to accommodate a wheelchair at a dining table and provide card payment options directly at the table. Impressively, over 60% of food establishments have accessible toilets, and 45% offer accessible changing facilities, making dining out more comfortable for all.
- Community support: Our local businesses are committed to fostering a supportive
  community environment; many support mental health awareness and ensure good
  lighting and clear signage. Additionally, several businesses can host autism-friendly early
  openings for services such as haircuts and eye tests.
- Shopmobility service: For those requiring mobility assistance, our Shopmobility service
  offers free mobility scooter hire on Tuesdays and Saturdays. Located conveniently in
  Cornwalls Meadow Car Park, it provides easy access to the town centre and nearby
  attractions.
